The “Queenslanders safe and thriving in culture, families and communities” motif was created as a symbol and visual narrative of the departments and communities collective journey and vision to ensure First Nations peoples cultural identity, diversity and richness are central to decisions made with regard to children, families and communities.

At the heart of the motif is a fire representing people coming together, gathering in warmth and safety.

The fire is fuelled by the exchange of stories and knowledge of each other and individually in self-determination.

Surrounding the fire is a dark layer of charcoal and smoke acknowledging both trauma and healing experienced by individuals, families or communities, as well centuries of strength and resilience.

The vibrant new growth represents new beginnings for individuals, families and communities through safety, understanding, self-determination, resilience and healing.

The interwoven support net represents where children, families, youth, women, justice and staff are supported by a network of partners to ensure that all Queenslanders are safe and thriving in culture, families and communities.
